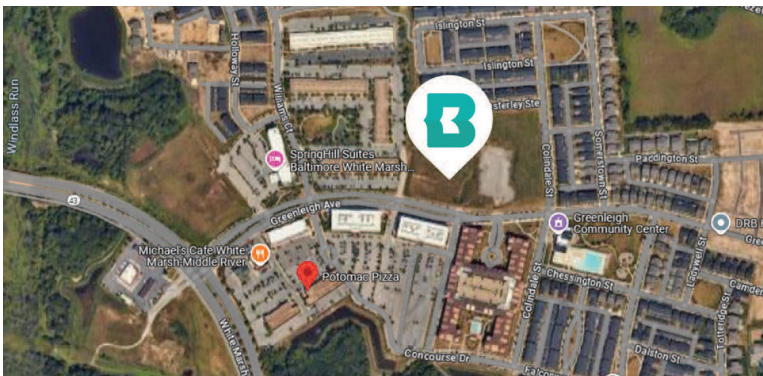


# MIDDLE RIVER BRANCH PROPOSAL



**Middle River is one of the fastest-growing communities in Baltimore County and currently does not have its own library branch.**

While residents of this community could conveniently visit branches in Essex, White Marsh or Perry Hall, data indicates that they do not.

Census tracts in the Middle River area have some of the lowest rates of library card holders in the county.

## New Middle River Branch

### The proposal includes:

- A 25,810-square-foot library branch
- Adjacent 116-space parking lot
- Location in the heart of the community
- The developer would build and maintain the branch
- Baltimore County would lease the property on behalf of the library system for 25 years

### Project Timeline

**The property is only being made available by the developer for this project through June 30, 2025.**

Once an agreement is executed, the design—including community input—and construction would take approximately 18 months.
